SCOBING

For grades 2nd thru 8th follows NFHS Scoring Rules with the exception of: Two (2) points shall be scored for a successful kick or drop kick after touchdown; One (1) point shall be scored for any other successful play after touchdown.

MERCY RULE

60-yard fields - If the disparity reaches 28 or more points, all plays will count and rule 30.4.2 will no longer be in effect. If the score is brought back to within 27 points, normal rules will go back in to effect. If the deficit reaches 40 points at any time, the score will be frozen and recorded. The game will continue on with all plays counting. 100-yard fields - If the disparity reaches 32 or more points, a running clock will be instituted. The clock will only stop on timeouts and injury timeouts until the score is brought back to within 31 points. A normal clock will begin again. If the deficit reaches 40 points at any time, the score will be frozen and recorded. The game will continue on with a running clock.

ON FIELD INSTRUCTIONS

One Rookie Tackle coach will be allowed on the field during games for the entire season, including playoffs and Carnation Bowl. One 3rd grade coach will be allowed on the field during games for the entire season with the limitations outlined in Rule 47.2.
